State Headquarters Announcements

1. This year the Service Officer Support has been raised to \$75.00. All other program donations remain at \$50.00 Each.

Post Announcements

1. Commander-in-Chief Carol Whitmore, Special Order 335 dated July 21st cancelled the charter of Pana Post 4431.
2. Eleven posts are currently suspended.
3. Two eligibility challenges are active.

Bylaws

1. Section 216: (a) The Post **shall** elect the Commander, Senior Vice Commander, Junior Vice Commander, Quartermaster, and three Trustees. (b) The Commander **shall** appoint an Adjutant and Chaplain.

The following posts have vacancies in violation of this bylaw and must correct it immediately.

2. Section 220: in part reads; Any elected Post officer or committee member removed, by reason of failure to pay current dues or under the provisions of this section shall not be eligible to serve in any Post office or committee in the same administrative year in which the officer or committee member is removed.

There are currently 171 Post or District Officers set to expire this year. Get your dues paid early to avoid a disruption in your service to your post or district

3. All Trustee Quarterly Reports for the 4th quarter ending June 30th were due to State HQ by July 31st.
4. As of July 1st, Posts and Districts may file IRS form 990 for the 2025 fiscal year. All are encouraged to complete this early.

5. Critical Notice: Upcoming Bond Expirations

Be advised that all current Post Officer bonds purchased through State Headquarters will officially expire on **August 31, 2026**. To ensure continuous, mandatory compliance and prevent any gap in required coverage, all Posts must submit their renewal applications immediately. Online bond applications for Post Commanders and Quartermasters are readily available for submission. Bonds purchased directly through State Headquarters strictly cover the positions of Commander and Quartermaster only, up to a maximum limit of \$1 million.

Posts requiring coverage exceeding \$1 million, or requiring administrative bonding for additional positions, must secure an independent policy through an outside insurance source. If an outside bond is utilized, a complete and legible copy of the policy must be forwarded to State Headquarters immediately to be maintained on official file.
