STATE CONVENTION

The State Convention will be held on June 11-14, 2026. The hotel for the State Convention is the Crowne Plaza, 3000 S. Dirksen Pkwy, Springfield, IL 62703

Information on reserving your room at the Crowne Plaza will be in the upcoming General Orders and on the vfwil.org web page under "Events".

STATE CONVENTION REGISTRATION

Included in these General Orders is the Advance Registration Form for the State Convention. Delegates can also register online at www.vfwil.org. The registration fee is \$20.00 until **May 31, 2026**, and is \$22.00 after **May 31, 2026**. Letters of registration confirmation will be mailed to registrants after the proper registration fee has been paid. Registrants will be required to present this confirmation when they check in at the convention registration desk at the Crowne Plaza

REMINDER: Delegates **will not** be allowed to vote if their Post is in arrears on supplies, poppies, or any other financial obligation to the Department. The Post must be bonded, have an approved inspection, have an election report on file with the Department and National Headquarters for the ensuing year, and all audits, including the March 31, 2026, audit, must be submitted and approved. The delegate strength to the convention is based on one delegate and one alternate delegate per thirty members or fraction thereof.

MARCH 25TH "MEDAL OF HONOR DAY"

A Resolution was passed by the U.S. Senate designating March 25th as "National Medal of Honor Day". The day is set aside to acknowledge the more than 3,400 individuals who have received the nation's highest honor. The date of March 25th was chosen to highlight this special day because it was on March 25, 1863, that the first Medals of Honor were presented to six members of Andrews' Raiders. According to the Medal of Honor Society, there are only 83 living individuals who have received the "Medal of Honor," and the Department of Illinois is proud to be "home" to three of them. They are Harold Fritz, Post 2078-9, Allen Lynch, Post 4308-5 and Sammy Davis, Post 4549-17.

DEPARTMENT BYLAW CHANGES

Amendments affecting the Bylaws of the Department must be submitted in ***proper form*** and received by State Headquarters no later than **May 15, 2026**. Any submissions received after that date cannot be considered at the convention. **If you have questions regarding the proper form, please contact State Headquarters.**

COMMUNITY ACTIVITIES RECORD BOOK

Community service, as defined by the National Community Service Trust Act, "encompasses any human act serving the common good in the interest of the community." Community service is "a service that is performed for the benefit of the public or its institutions."

Annually, we ask all VFW Posts to submit record books detailing their Community Service Projects. We encourage Posts to gather pictures, newspaper clippings, letters, receipts, etc., and compile this vital record of their activities in their community.

Please contact State Headquarters if you have any questions.

When the Community Activity Record Books are submitted for judging, they must have the official

entry form attached to the inside front cover. The Official Entry Form is in the Commander's Leadership Manual, and at the end of these orders, your record book must be at State Headquarters by **May 2, 2026**, judging on **May 5, 2026**

CONVENTION AWARDS AND CITATIONS COMMITTEE:

We are accepting nominations for our State Convention Awards & Citations Committee. Categories for these awards are Outstanding Legislator, Education, Outstanding in Industrial Field, Legal Profession, Athletic Field, Governmental Service, Clergy, News Media, and Outstanding Citizen or Community.

There is no *form to fill out...just write down the name, address, sponsoring Post Number, Contact Person and the reason why you feel this individual deserves to be recognized.* **THE DEADLINE DATE IS April 30, 2026**

NOMINATION, ELECTION AND INSTALLATION OF OFFICERS

Section 217 of the Constitution, By-Laws and Manual of Procedure, states that prior to the opening of nominations, the Post shall decide which form of election shall be used, unless the Post By-Laws specify the manner of election. Any nominee shall have the opportunity to decline nomination for the office to which they have been nominated before nominations are closed. A member making the nomination of an absentee for any office shall have presented to the Adjutant, in writing, the consent of the member being nominated prior to the opening of nominations. Nominations of Post Officers shall open in March and remain open until the Post is ready to vote, provided, however, that when a poll system is used, nominations must be closed at the meeting prior to the election to allow the Adjutant to prepare a printed ballot.

Post officers shall be elected in April. Balloting for Post Officers may be conducted by open vote or written secret ballot (handwritten or printed) at a regular Post Meeting, or, if required by Post By-laws or authorized by Post vote prior to the opening of nominations, by a poll system and preprinted ballot.

Challenging Election Results: If irregularities are claimed with respect to the election to any office, such a challenge must be made prior to the closing of the meeting.

REMINDER - POST/DISTRICT OFFICER CHANGES OR CORRECTIONS

Please note that changes in Post or District Officers must be reported to State Headquarters immediately. Changes in addresses, phone numbers, and e-mail addresses should also be reported immediately - even if changes are made on the Online Membership System (OMS). These changes are not always transmitted to State Headquarters; please help us keep our records up to date.

IMPORTANT NOTICE

Sec. 413 - Arrearages, Deficiencies and Omissions.

The Commander of the District in arrears for financial obligations to Department or National, for fees, dues, poppy money, supply money, or failing to have the office of the Quartermaster properly bonded in accordance with Section 703, failing to ensure that the District is properly insured in accordance with Section 709, failing to submit properly completed District Trustees Report of Audit, District Election Report for the ensuing year, or other obligations, shall be deprived of all representation at the Department

Convention. Such representation shall be restored promptly upon proper adjustment of such deficiencies. A properly completed District Election Report shall be submitted to National Headquarters prior to the convening of the Department Convention.

Sec. 213 - Arrearages, Deficiencies and Omissions.

Any Post in arrears for any financial obligations to County Council (if applicable), District, Department and National for fees, dues, poppy money, supply money, failing to have the office of Quartermaster properly bonded in accordance with Section 703, failing to ensure that the Post is properly insured in accordance with Section 709, failing to submit properly completed quarterly Post Trustees Report of Audit, Post Election Report for the ensuing year, or other obligations, shall be deprived of all representation in County Council and District meetings; County Council, District, Department and National Conventions. Such representation shall be restored promptly upon proper adjustment of such deficiencies.

VOTING AT DISTRICT CONVENTIONS

Section 421 Voting - Each member of a District Convention or District meeting are those persons as defined in Section 404, except delegates elected by the Posts, present at a District Convention or meeting shall be entitled to one vote, and an individual possessing more than one qualification for membership in the District Convention or meeting shall have no more than one vote. The delegate or delegates of a Post present at a District Convention or meeting shall be entitled to vote the full delegate strength to which the Post is entitled. Should there be a division among the delegates representing the Post, each delegate present and voting shall cast their pro rata share of the Post's total voting strength. For the purpose of this section, a Post Commander shall be considered a delegate. A roll call vote may be required and entered upon the record at the call of any three officers or delegates representing three different Posts.

127th VFW NATIONAL CONVENTION

Reno, NV, is the host city for the 127th VFW and 112th Auxiliary National Conventions, which will be held July 25-29, 2026. Convention housing will open on March 17, 2026. We will release more information as we receive it. Housing reservation information will be located on the convention website accessed through the main VFW website at vfw.org/convention. The convention website will also include general convention information, such as the registration form, links to other Reno, NV – July 25-29, 2026, convention-related materials, and a tentative agenda.

NATIONAL CONVENTION REGISTRATION

Section 222 of the Manual of Procedure states that each Post will pay, in advance, a National Convention Registration Fee of \$25, which shall entitle the Post to a packet of convention information and materials and one identified registered delegate for the National Convention. Please note that each additional delegate attending the National Convention will have to pay an additional \$10 delegate fee. Information on delegate registration will be available at a later date.

COUNCIL OF ADMINISTRATION AND COMMANDERS HOMECOMING

The August Council of Administration and Commanders Homecoming in Joliet is scheduled for August 7-9, 2026. Please save the date; additional information will be provided in the upcoming General Orders.

BUDDY POPPY PROGRAM

Order your poppies now for your Memorial Day distribution or for your Poppy Display. You can order electronically from our webpage - <http://www.vfwil.org>, using the "Donate Now button, or fill out the form and email, mail, or fax it, or just call us. **Effective March 1, 2026, Poppy orders must be paid in full,**

including shipping and handling, before Poppies will be sent

Please keep in mind:

- You can order in increments of 500. Traditional poppies are priced at \$280 for 1000 or \$140 for 1000 tin tab poppies.
- Your poppies should be ordered 6 to 8 weeks before your distribution.
- Your order will be shipped to the *name* of the person who ordered them and the address submitted with the order.
- Poppies can be paid for by check or by credit card. **Please submit payment with your order or pay promptly when invoiced.**
- Poppy cans, caps, table covers, vests, aprons, etc., are ordered directly from the [VFW Store](#) at National Headquarters.






