As many of you know COVID really changed the way we all had to go about our days. From running a business to simply going to the store for



### News from the Auxiliary



Jeff & Phyllis Wilson from the Salvage Dogs


were also present as money they donated to the Auxiliary helped to fund our 2nd scholarship we awarded this year—a big thanks to them for their generosity.




